In addition to Cooney's film work, he is also part of the British theater world. His stage writing credits include the comedy **Cash On Delivery** that had it's world premier at the prestigious Theatre Royal Windsor and has gone on to break box office records throughout Europe. **Cash on Delivery** ran for a year in London's West End before beginning a nationwide tour. His two stage thrillers, **The Dark Side** and **Point of Death** have both enjoyed successful British tours.

Brian Wallace (Mr. Jenkins) is making his Los Angeles stage debut, after watching his hairline fade away when working out of New York. While back East, he established an off-Broadway career and appeared with several LORT companies around the country, such as the Alabama Shakespeare Festival, Arkansas Rep, Berkshire Theatre Festival, Capital Rep, Dallas Theater Center, Palm Beach Dramaworks, the Public/NYSF and Trinity Rep. Brian has originated roles for many noted playwrights, including William Gibson, Quiara Hudes, Tracey Scott Wilson and Elyzabeth Gregory Wilder.
